## **Covenant Enforcement:**

Most of us follow the covenants, but unfortunately a few do not. This is a reminder of the Top Three most frequently violated covenants. Please do your part to keep Hidden Hills a sought-after neighborhood!

**Parking on the Street** - creates traffic congestion and hinders pedestrians.

Boats & Trailers - all boats & trailers should be hidden from site

**Utility trailers** - should be screened from view, either by parking in your garage or back yard, behind a fence.

Parking on the street is the number one violation. Parking on the street in any part of the Development, including the Common Areas, is prohibited.
