**POOL RULES NO LIFEGUARDS ON DUTY** 

## Children under 16 years of age must be accompanied by an adult resident.

Climbing over the fence is NOT allowed.

There is a 2-guest limit per household.

**POOL PARTIES ARE NOT ALLOWED DUE TO SIZE OF POOL.** 

Pool hours are 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.

Residents may gain access to the pool and exercise room with the key provided to each homeowner (1 key per lot). Lost

keys will be replaced for a \$20 charge.

Be sure the gate closes behind you and

do not admit anyone without a key.

Propping the gate open is forbidden.

Persons with skin diseases, open sores, inflamed eyes, nasal or ear discharges, or any diseases which are readily communicable may not use the

swimming pool until such time as the

disease is no longer communicable.

 Glass is prohibited. · Sand, dirt, and grass must be removed before entering the pool. · Running is not permitted in the pool area. Diving is not permitted in any area of the pool.

# Adding trees, porches, a fence, or a pool?

# Fences should be six foot tall (6') good neighbor fences with either only cedar or only cypress boards. No treated pine or synthetic fence boards will be allowed. See

approved fence detail page 7 - Appendix A. Outside areas deemed as "storage areas," shall be fenced "to a minimum height of six feet and a maximum height of eight feet."

The Hidden Hills Board has been receiving calls and verbal comments about fences which are falling down or in need of repair. We need every homeowner to be aware of your fence - especially the fences that are shared by neighbors. It is each neighbor's responsibility to make sure the fence is maintained. Below is a short synopsis of some of the ARC's guidelines & rules concerning your fence(s).

**FENCES**

**Walls and Fences** All retaining walls should be approved in advance by the ARC. Walls exceeding four feet (4') in height must be permitted by the Rankin County Community Development

(Article X, Section 3, of the Covenants for Hidden Hills) This requirement will be relaxed only in instances where the slope of the ground is excessive. Fences are to be constructed to comply with the covenant to the greatest

homeowner does choose to stain his or her fence only clear or semi-transparent stain will be considered. PAINTS are not acceptable.

Fences are not required to be stained, natural weathering is acceptable. If a
