Music may be used with earphones only. Appropriate swimming attire must be worn. No cut-offs, dungarees and Bermuda

Diapers are prohibited in the pool. Swim diapers must be worn by children who are not

No Rough Play. Boisterous conduct and rough play are prohibited. Offensive language, inappropriate behavior, horseplay, or any other activity that

Furniture may only be "saved" for a few minutes.

Pool furniture is available on a "first come, first served basis".
