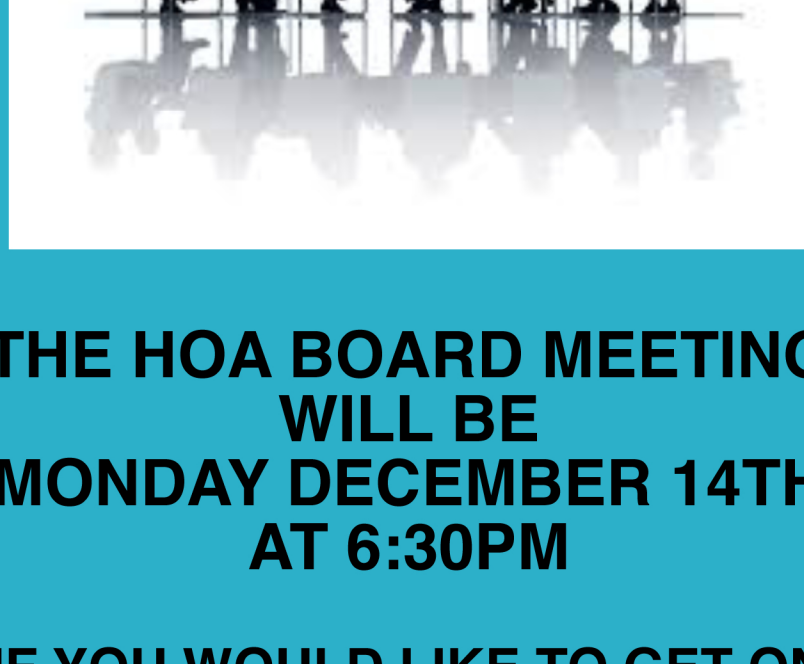
## Architectural Review Committee Needs Volunteers

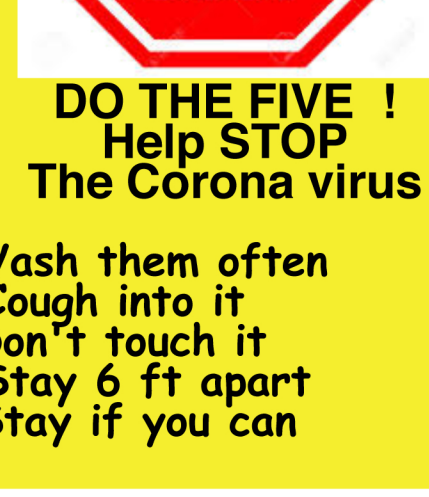
