Pool News & Etiquette

School is out and the pool is being used daily, so it may be helpful to review some of our rules:

- 1. No Lifeguards on duty. Children under 16 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- 2. Pool hours are 8:00 a.m. -9:00 p.m. You must use the side gate (and your key) for access.
- 3. Be sure the gate closes behind you. Do not let anyone in without a key.
- 4. Glass is prohibited. Kindly use plastic or cans.
- 5. No running, diving, or rough play is allowed. Offensive language is prohibited.
- 6. Residents must clean up after themselves and their children. Properly dispose of all trash in the receptacles, and keep the bathrooms clean.
- 7. Diapers are not allowed in the pool. Swim diapers must be worn by children who are not potty trained.
- 8. Animals are not permitted in the pool at any time.
- 9. Music may be played with earphones. No loud music permitted.
- 10. Inflatable rafts and floats are not permitted. Small inner tubes and noodles are allowed.

DID YOU KNOW?

The Board of Directors has identified <u>Approved Stain Colors</u> for fences in Hidden Hills. At the Board of Directors meeting in November 2013, the following revision was approved for the Architectural Guidelines:

Fences are not required to be stained. Natural weathering is totally acceptable. If a homeowner chooses to stain their fence, only clear or semi-transparent stain will be considered. PAINTS are not acceptable. The Board of Directors has identified Approved Stain Colors in a range of browns from Sherwin Williams identified as SW 3508, SW 3511, SW 3513, SW 3509, and SW 3504, which all can be found on Sherwin Williams Woodscapes color sample card 277. Stains purchased from other retailers may be acceptable if similar to approved stain colors.

Application for staining of all fences is to be submitted to the ARC. The approved colors are provided below.



The purpose of <u>Approved Stain Colors</u> is to maintain continuity throughout our community. The aesthetic relationship or "look" of the neighborhood is to be maintained from one fence to the next throughout Hidden Hills.

Note that red, black, and other colors have not been identified as <u>Approved Stain Colors</u> by the Board of Directors. **Presumably any such fences were stained prior to November 2013**.
