DID YOU KNOW?

The Reservoir Community District (RCD) Agreement was enacted last year and now governs the construction of Accessory Structures in Hidden Hills. The RCD, otherwise known as the Overlay District is designed to achieve the following goals:

A. Protect property values;

B. Insure the harmonious, orderly, and efficient growth and development of the District;

C. Strengthen civic pride and cultural stability through neighborhood conservation;

D. Strengthen the economy of the District through the continued use, preservation, and revitalization of its commercial areas;

E. Protect and enhance the District's attractions to tourists and visitors and the support and stimulus to business and industry thereby provided;

As a result of the agreement, Rankin County now is responsible for provisions of the agreement by ordinance. Section 2608 specifically states that a building permit is required on all accessory buildings. In the past, approval for the construction of storage and auxiliary buildings was granted by the Architectural Review Committee for Hidden Hills. The provisions of the RCD now supplement the Covenants and Architectural Guidelines of Hidden Hills. Section 2608 reads in full as follows:

SECTION 2608 – ACCESSORY STRUCTURES

2608.01 Accessory Buildings or uses are PROHIBITED in the front yard and side yard in any platted subdivision of this district.

2608.02 Accessory buildings or uses may be placed in the required rear yard of any main building or use in any platted subdivision, provided that the accessory building or use is at least five (5) feet from the rear and side property lines.

2608.03 Accessory buildings shall not cover more than ten percent (10%) of the rear yard in platted subdivisions.

2608.04 Accessory buildings shall not exceed a height of twelve (12) feet.

2608.05 Exterior and materials of the accessory buildings or uses **shall be constructed of same exterior material and color as the primary structure, unless accessory building is screened** by solid fencing as not to be visible from the street or any sides.

2608.06 A building permit is required on all accessory buildings.

Residents should submit their application directly to Rankin County Community Development Department, 117 N. Timber Street, Brandon 39042. Renee Lawrence is the Director and the office number is <u>601-824- 2570</u>.

After the building permit is obtained and prior to construction, applicants should then complete the ARC Application that is available at the <u>Hidden Hills website</u> and advise Hidden Hills Association Manager <u>Pat Starnes</u> or ARC Chairman <u>Rod Nagel</u>.
