# **Q&A:** How Do I Reserve the Clubhouse?

This is one of our most frequently asked questions. The clubhouse rental fee is \$50, and the refundable security deposit is \$100. To reserve the clubhouse for a private event, check the calendar at <a href="Hidden Hills Owners">Hidden Hills</a> Owners to see if the date is available. If available, print the two forms, <a href="Clubhouse Usage Agreement">Clubhouse Usage Agreement</a> and <a href="Conditions for Clubhouse Use">Conditions for Clubhouse Use</a>. Bring your completed forms along with two separate checks to the clubhouse. You can use the after-hours drop box which is attached to the building beside the front door. The key can be picked up the Friday before your weekend event and must be returned no later than Monday morning. The dates are reserved on a first come/first served basis, and we cannot hold the date without payment.

#### **POOL USE:**

In a couple of weeks, school will be out and the pool will be used on a daily basis. Please help keep the pool area clean by utilizing the trash receptacles and checking the restrooms after small children.

Due to the growth of the neighborhood and the number of residents who use the pool, pool parties are no longer allowed. There is a two-guest limit per household. Children under the age of 16 should be accompanied by an adult resident.

## **Covenant Corner – Permitted Signs**

Are you familiar with this covenant?

Article VIII, Section 13: No sign of any kind shall be displayed to public view except (1) one For Sale sign; (2) a security notice sign no more than two square feet in area; (3) any political sign no more than four square feet in area which can be displayed no more than thirty (30) days prior to any election date and which is removed within five (5) days after the election. So, signs advertising a business, i.e., yard services, painters, handyman services, etc., are not allowed.
